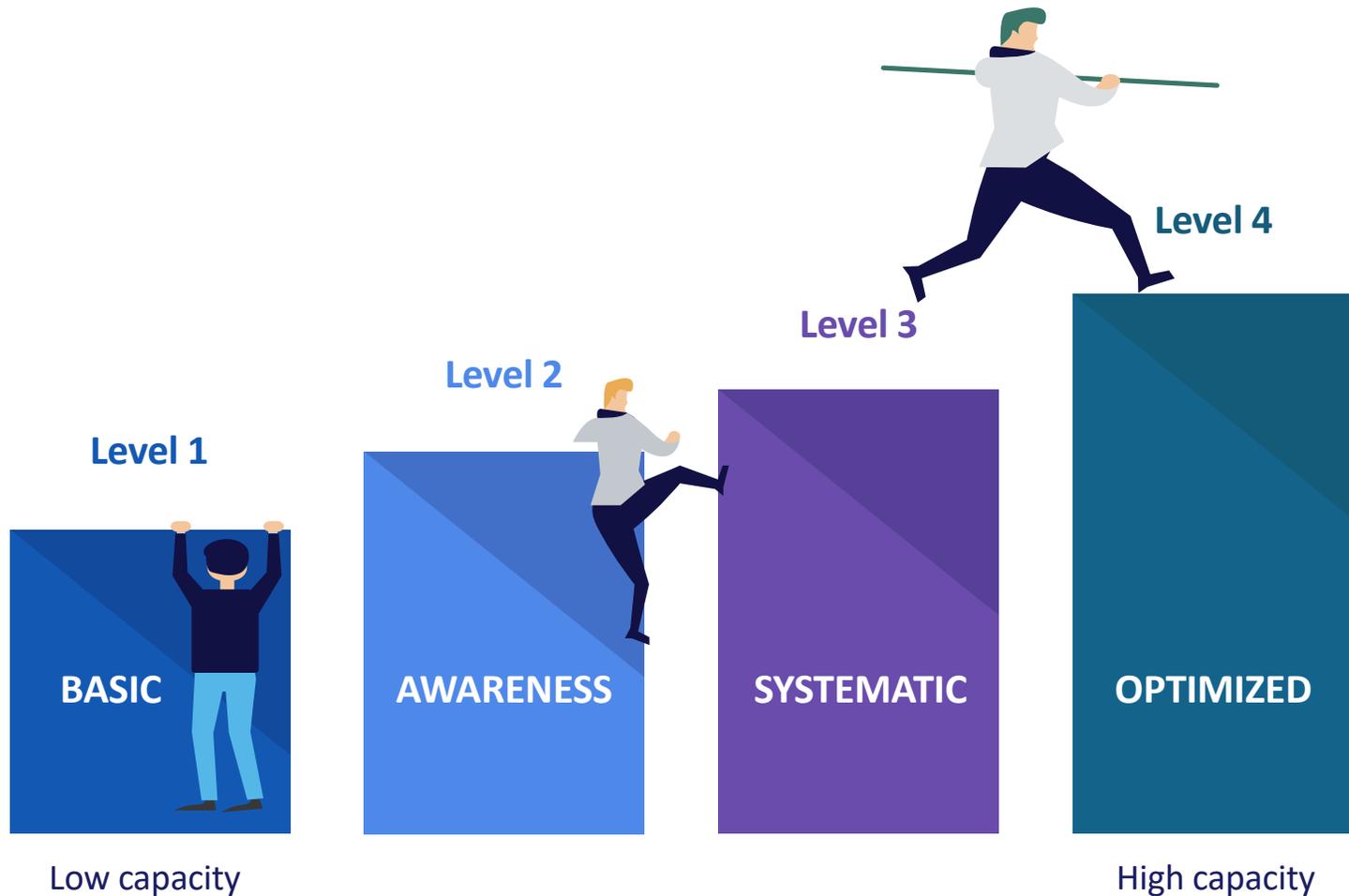

# The road map's maturity Model



## A diagnostic tool

that enables NSSs to assess their current level of data maturity

## A prescriptive tool

for identifying desired maturity levels and how to achieve them by suggesting actions to reach a desired maturity level

## A comparative tool

that enables benchmarking progress made against industry/international standards and peers especially in the same region

# Ongoing work

- Self-Assessment via the Maturity Matrix
- Mainstreaming enablers for transformation and modernization into the NSDS
- Mainstreaming the national quality assurance framework into the road map

# Some Achievements in NSS transformation in recent years

## Legal and Strategic Reforms

- **Countries modernizing** statistical laws: Benin, Burundi.
- **Gender integration** in strategies: Madagascar, Niger, Senegal, Somalia.
- **Toolkit for child rights mainstreaming** developed by ECA & UNICEF.
- **Updated statistical law** navigator by the Partnership in Statistics for Development in the 21st Century.

## Communication and Advocacy

- **Madagascar and Sierra Leone:** Developed national communication strategies.
- **Ethiopia:** Received training on statistical communication from ECA & Statistics Norway.
- **“Power of Data” initiative:** Launched to support SDGs and Agenda 2063.

## Data Innovation and Integration

- **StatsTalk-Africa webinars:** knowledge-sharing sessions.
- **Training in R, SEEA, small area estimation.**
- **Leadership programmes:** Over 280 participants trained.
- **“Women into Leadership” initiative:** Empowering women statisticians

## Financial Investments

- **World Bank:** Approved \$460M for data system improvements in West Africa.
- **Additional grants:** \$60M (CAR), \$105M (Chad & Cameroon).
- **Chad:** Increased domestic funding for statistics after advocacy.

## Technological Advancements

- **Digital census infrastructure:** Tablets and apps deployed in Malawi, Namibia, Togo.
- **AI-powered chatbot:** Answers SDG-related data queries.
- **Open data platforms:** Strengthened via AfDB and ECA support.

## Youth Engagement

- **Takwimu Programme:** Mentorship for young African statisticians.
- **UN Datathon 2023:** Ghana team won with climate and nutrition data solutions.
- **Regional hub website launched:** Facilitates collaboration in data science.
